To be eligible to apply to a 4-year college in California; such as a University of California (UC) and California State University (CSU) students need to complete classes, referred to as A-G, with a grade of C/P or better. Below is a tracking chart for you to input your grades for A-G courses. If you need to remediate a course it is recommended you complete it prior to senior year. Speak to your School Counselor for ways to remediate classes you may have received a D or F. Below are the minimum A-G requirements; any additional classes that fit the A-G category will also be used to calculate your college admission GPA.
