The PSAT 8/9 helps students determine what they need to work on most so that they're ready for college when they graduate from high school. The PSAT 8/9 includes and Reading Test, a Writing and Language Test, and a Math Test. Taking the PSAT 8/9 will also give students access to personalized SAT practice online through Khan Academy.

Who, Where, When

- Who: Eighth Grade Students
- Where: Golden West (Rooms assignments will be posted prior to test day)
- When: Saturday April 13th, 8:30 a.m.- 12:30 p.m.

Fees

There will be no fee for this test. Students who register must have arranged transportation to and from school on test day.

What to Bring

- Two No. 2 pencils with erasers
- [An approved calculator](#) (See College Board website for list of approved calculators)
- School photo ID and Student ID number

During the Test

You will be allowed to have only these items on your desk:

- A test book
- An answer sheet
- No. 2 pencils with erasers
- [An approved calculator](#)—during one of the math sections only
