

1. What are the dates of summer school?

- ⇒ Summer School will take place from June 11-22
- ⇒ Students will attend Monday – Friday
- ⇒ One session— Cyber High only
- ⇒ The Principal for Summer School is Allyson Rude Azevedo.

2. Where is summer school?

Summer school will be at **Travis Education Center** at 2775 DeRonde Drive in Fairfield. During the summer, the contact number is 707-437-8265. Office hours are 7:15 am to 2:30 pm.

3. What are the hours of summer school?

Summer school will begin at 7:30 am and end at 2:10 pm.

4. Who is eligible for summer school? Why?

Due to the aggressive credit recovery during the school year, only seniors are eligible for Summer School at TEC. Requests for exceptions should be addressed to Ms. Rude

5. How will summer school credits be calculated and reported on the transcript?

The variable credit system will be used, just as it is used during the regular school year.

6. How do I enroll for summer school?

TEC students should work with the counselor if summer school is needed.

7. What classes may be offered during summer school?

Cyber High Courses only

8. Will there be transportation and food available during summer school?

Transportation to and from summer school is available. Please contact or visit the transportation department if you are interested in purchasing a Summer School bus pass. Please call TUSD Transportation at 437-8232.

Lunch will be provided daily for a fee (\$2.85). Cash will not be accepted during meal time. Students must have a positive balance on their account to purchase meals. 9. What if I live on base?

Forbes Gate will be open to allow for student access in the morning and after school.

10. What is the attendance and tardy policy?

In order to complete course assignments and earn credit for the course, attendance is important. **There are no excused absences.** **Students will be dropped from Summer School on the seventh (7) absent hour regardless of the reason.** **Three (3) tardies will equal one (1) hour of absence.** Please plan your doctor, dentist, or personal appointments in the afternoon.

11. What is the discipline policy?

Students who receive 2 suspensions will be automatically dropped from summer school. Parents will be notified at the time of each suspension. Students are expected to follow all TEC school rules including behavior and dress code as stated in the student handbook. The student handbook can be viewed on the TEC website. Paper copies of the handbook will be made available upon request to the administration.
