

# Vanden High School Summer Credit Recovery Opportunity

## General Information:

To enroll in Summer Cyber High Credit Recovery, students should see their counselor before the end of the school year. Students will be given the Cyber High Contract that must be signed by student and parent. Students must bring the signed contract to Cyber Lab hours to meet with an instructor, get officially enrolled and have a Cyber High Orientation.

**Cyber High Lab Location:** Library Computer Lab

**Dates:** June 11<sup>th</sup> through August 8<sup>th</sup>, Tuesdays (8am-11am) and Thursdays (12pm-4pm)

## FAQs:

### What is Summer Credit Recovery program?

- An online learning opportunity for VHS students to remediate Ds and Fs and to meet graduation requirements using the coursework of Cyber High.
- Cyber High courses may meet UC A-G requirements.
- Cyber High courses do not meet NCAA eligibility requirements.

### Who can participate in Summer Credit Recovery?

Vanden students needing to remediate D's or F's can work with their counselor to decide if Cyber High credit recovery is an option for them.

### Do students need to attend every lab session?

No. Students must attend an initial orientation to begin their course. This can be on any lab day. Students must attend lab session to take the required exams. If a student is away on vacation, they can continue working on their course on any device and then attend lab hours to complete exams when they return.

### Is this a traditional classroom seat course?

No, students in the Cyber High program will primarily work independently on their Cyber High course(s). Students will be required to attend an Orientation Session at VHS before starting their course when they begin their first Cyber High course. Students are also required to be on campus during designated lab hours to take exams for their course.

### What supports will VHS provide to summer Cyber High students?

During weekly designated lab hours, the Cyber High teachers will be available to assist students with their course. Students can communicate via email with their Cyber High teacher for assistance when not on campus during lab hours.

### Are IEP/504 accommodations available during summer Cyber High?

The Cyber High coursework is self-paced, and the Cyber High teacher will work with the student so testing accommodations are met.

### Is there a deadline for completion of the Cyber High course?

Yes, students must complete all components of the course(s) by July 31st.

### What will help a student succeed in summer Cyber High courses?

- Working diligently on the coursework
- Attending lab hours/ tutoring hours regularly when needed

### What if a student does not complete their coursework?

The independent nature of online learning does not match all students' learning needs. For some students, it may be that re-enrolling in the seat class during the school year is a better path for credit recovery. Students who need more time after July 31st may have an opportunity to return to the course after the school year begins, but this is not a guarantee.
