**Resolution 2021-22-10
SUFFICIENCY OF STANDARDS-ALIGNED TEXTBOOKS AND
INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS FOR 2021-22 SCHOOL YEAR**

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of Travis Unified School District, in order to comply with the requirements of Education Code Section 60119, held a public hearing on Tuesday, September 14, 2020, at 6:00 PM, which is on or before the eighth week of school (between the first day that students attend school and the end of the eighth week from that day) and which did not take place during or immediately following school hours; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Board provided at least a 10-day notice of the public hearing posted in at least three public places within the district that stated the time, place, and purpose of the hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Board encouraged participation by parents, teachers, members of the community, and bargaining unit leaders in the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, information provided at the public hearing and to the Governing Board at the public meeting detailed the extent to which textbooks and instructional materials were provided to all students, including English learners, in the Travis Unified School District; and

WHEREAS, the definition of "sufficient textbooks or instructional materials" means that each student, including each English learner, has a standards-aligned textbook or instructional materials to use in class and to take home, which may include materials in a digital format but shall not include photocopied sheets from only a portion of a textbook or instructional material copied to address a shortage, and;

WHEREAS, sufficient textbooks and instructional materials were provided to each student, including English learners that are aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks in the following subjects:

- Mathematics
- Science
- History-social science
- English/language arts, including the English language development component of an adopted program

WHEREAS, sufficient textbooks or instructional materials were provided to each pupil enrolled in foreign language or health classes; and

WHEREAS, laboratory science equipment was available for science laboratory classes offered in grades 9-12, inclusive;

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NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that for the 2021-2022 school year, Travis Unified School District has provided each pupil with sufficient textbooks and instructional materials aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks.


