# **COVID-19 Verification of Vaccination or Testing**

for

Staff, Volunteers, Guests, Visitors and Spectators

Hello Travis USD Community,

Travis Unified School District (TUSD) is committed to protecting the health and safety of our students, staff and community. In accordance with the California State Public Health Officer Order of August 11, 2021, "workers" on transitional kindergarten through Grade 12 school campuses must wear a mask at all times and provide verification of vaccination or verification of a negative COVID-19 test to be on a school campus. The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) guidance recommends limiting nonessential visitors, volunteers, and activities involving external groups or organizations with people who are not fully vaccinated.

In order to comply and provide a safe and healthy environment, this is what you can expect if you plan to visit a school site:

- Masks are required at all times
- Verification of Vaccination or verification of diagnostic screening testing is required as follows:

Verification of vaccination or testing does not apply to parents who are briefly present to pick up or drop off a child in the office.

Verification of full vaccination or testing (within 72 hours of the specimen collection date) does apply to all employees, volunteers, guest speakers and visitors coming on campus to attend a parent conference/meeting or attend an activity or event in excess of 15 minutes on campus.

### **Athletics**

Athletics are governed by the California Interscholastic Federation (CIF) which has adopted guidance unique to high school sports both indoors and outdoors. All sports at Vanden High School will follow these guidelines.

### **Other Activities and Events**

All other school related activities and events must receive prior approval from the site administrator in collaboration with the District Office and guidance from from the Solano Public Health (SPH) and California Department of Public Health (CDPH). Each activity or event will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. Other school related activities and events include, but are not limited to assemblies, band performances, robotics activities and competitions, athletic events during school hours and activities that support school functions such as fund raising, operations of snack bars or others activities.

# **How to provide Verification of Vaccination**

1) Fully vaccinated visitors, observers and spectators can provide verification by submitting a copy of your vaccination card to your site secretary or designee.

# How to provide proof of negative diagnostic testing

- 1) Who do I provide verification to?
  - a) You can provide a hard copy to the site Secretary or designee.
- 2) How often must I provide verification?
  - b) Beginning October 20, 2021, volunteers and staff must provide verification weekly. If you are a visitor, you can provide verification of a negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours of the specimen collection date.
- 3) How do I get tested?
  - c) You may utilize a test result from your healthcare provider or from any free local testing location.

If you do not submit verification of full vaccination, your status and any requirements will be treated as an unvaccinated status until we receive confirmation stating otherwise. This will include, but is not limited to wearing a compliant face covering and submitting a negative COVID-19 test in order to be eligible to participate in any on-campus activity as a volunteer.
