We apologize for any confusion regarding the COVID Protocols and Masking message sent today at 11:19 a.m. Please disregard and refer to the updated information below.

Due to the number of positive COVID-19 cases in your student's classroom at Center Elementary, we have been directed by Solano County Public Health to increase our vigilance with our safety precautions. Students will be required to wear a mask covering their nose and mouth while indoors through Friday, May 20, 2022. Cloth and disposable masks are available from the school or your child may bring one from home. In addition, students will be eating their meals outdoors.
