



Transitional Kindergarten Program In Sixth Year in Travis Unified 2017-18



In 2010, SB1381, the Kindergarten Readiness Act was signed into law by Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger. SB 1381 changes the Kindergarten age entry date in California from December 2nd to September 1st though it was legislated as a three year phase-in process starting with the 2012-13 school year.

SB 1381 authorizes all school districts in California to provide a Transitional Kindergarten (TK) program to better prepare children for success in Kindergarten and beyond.

TKUSD's 2017-18 Transitional Kindergarten program will accept students who turn 5 years-old between September 2, 2017 and December 2, 2017.

Registration is open for Transitional Kindergarten for 2017-18. To navigate to the on-line registration process on the Travis USD webpage click [here](#).

Locations for Transitional Kindergarten are dependent on enrollment and classroom availability and are subject to change each year. Due to Transitional Kindergarten not being offered at each school site, parents will be notified of the program location once that has been determined. Transportation will not be provided.
