Grading:

Students will earn a grade based on their performance in these main areas:

Assignments, Notebook Assessments, Test/Quizzes, Projects, and Participation.

NOTE: All work must be turned in on time. Any work turned in late will not earn credit. Students have two days for the first day absent to make up any work and one additional day per day absent. All work must be turned in with your name to earn credit.

The grading scale is as follows: **A= 90-100%, B= 80-89%, C= 70-79%, D= 55-69%, F= 0-54%.**
