This is a copy of the letter that is distributed to all high school students in Grades 9, 10, and 11 regarding the California High School Exit Exam (CAHSEE). It is important that parents of 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students are also made aware of the process and requirements of this program. Please understand that a foundation of knowledge and understanding of the two areas of the exam, English language arts and math, are deeply imbedded within the curriculum at the middle school level.

## California High School Exit Exam

Students in the class of 2006 were the first in California required to pass the CAHSEE in order to receive a high school diploma and as required by law under Education Code 60851. Previously passed California legislation signed into law by the Governor and section 60852.3 of the Education Code includes exemptions to the requirement of passing the CAHSEE for students with disabilities, but all students in California are still required to take the CAHSEE during 10th grade in order to comply with the Federal No Child Left Behind Act.

#### Algebra I Requirement

Prior to receiving a diploma of graduation from high school, all students must also meet or exceed the rigor of the content standards for Algebra I, as adopted by the State Board of Education.

#### What the California High School Exit Exam Covers

The CAHSEE exam is divided into two parts: (1) English-language arts (reading and writing), and (2) mathematics. All questions are aligned to content standards adopted by the State Board of Education. Content standards describe what students should know and be able to do at each grade level from kindergarten through grade 12.

#### **Graduation Requirements**

Beginning in 2006, in order to receive their high school diploma, students must pass both parts of the **CAHSEE** by earning a score of 350 or higher on each part. Students also must meet the Travis Unified School District's requirements for graduation.

### **Student Testing**

The **CAHSEE** will be given at the high school site to high school students during regular school hours on the designated dates. Students will:

- receive the results of the exam within eight weeks after testing is completed;
- have as many as six opportunities in high school to retake the exam or either part not passed;
- receive additional instruction, if needed, to help ensure success;
- not have their tests scored if caught cheating.
